

Preliminary Call For Papers, CSANA at Kalamazoo May 2019

Professor Fred Suppe will again be organizing sessions sponsored by CSANA for the annual International Medieval Studies Congress which will occur in Kalamazoo, Michigan on May 9- 12, 2019. He has proposed two CSANA sessions under the rubrics: "New Work by Young Celtic Studies Scholars" and "Names, Words, Terms, and Labels in Celtic Studies" to the general conference organizers. The first rubric welcomes papers on any topic relevant to Celtic Studies in any of the relevant academic disciplines proposed by scholars who are in the early stages of their academic careers. The second rubric is deliberately cast to accommodate a wide range of paper topics from any discipline relevant to Celtic Studies. While we will not receive official confirmation for these two proposed sessions until early in July 2018, Fred invites scholars who would like to present a paper under one of these rubrics to contact him with their ideas and potential titles now.
