Abstracts should not exceed 200 words and should include titles and affiliations.

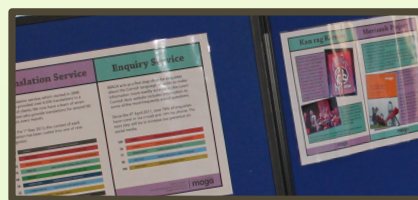
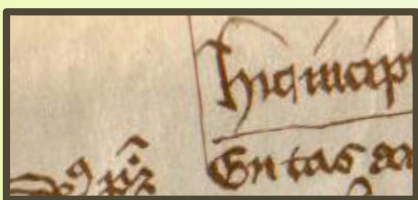
Papers should be planned for up to 20 minutes. There will be room given for
